IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presence of anyone without the consent of the court, or any recording of the audio/video "Zoom" conference/proceeding other than by the Court, may be considered contempt of court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in addition to pleadings, all motions, exceptions, memorandums in support, and memorandums in opposition must include the email address of the signatory in the signature block.
